Warm up question:

• Do you ever find it hard to receive love? Why do you think this is?

Read Ephesians 3:1-13

- 1. Chapter 3 begins with the words "For this reason... you Gentiles" What was written about the Gentiles in chapter 2?
- 2. The word "mystery" is repeated 4 times. What is this mystery? Why is the word mystery used?
- 3. How was this mystery made known/revealed?
- 4. How does Paul describe himself throughout verses 1-13?
- 5. What is the role of the church in verses 10-11?
- 6. What does verse 12 say about how we can approach God?

Read Ephesians 3:14-21

- 7. What does Paul pray for in this section?
- 8. The word "*love*" is repeated 3 times. How is the word "*love*" used? How did Paul use the word "*love*" in chapters 1 & 2? (See 1:4, 1:6, 1:15 & 2:4)
- 9. What does Paul say about the church / the Lord's holy people in this section?
- 10. How would you summarise verses 20-21?
- 11. What is your overall feeling of this passage? How would you sum it up?

Rubber hits the road:

- How has Ephesians 1-3 challenged the way you perceive the grace that God has lavished on you?
- How can we (the church) continue to make known the "manifold wisdom of God"?
